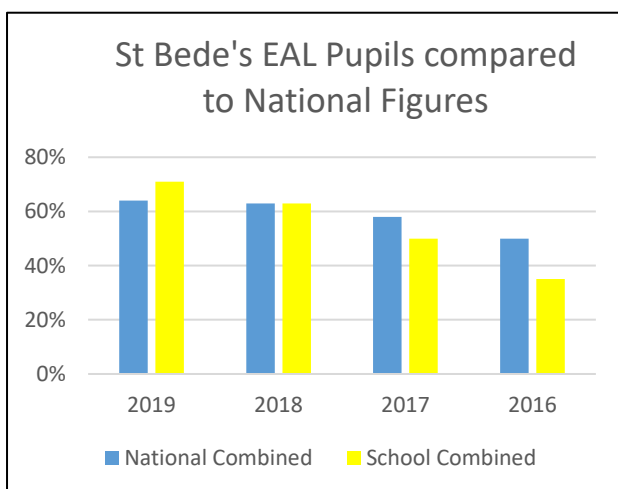
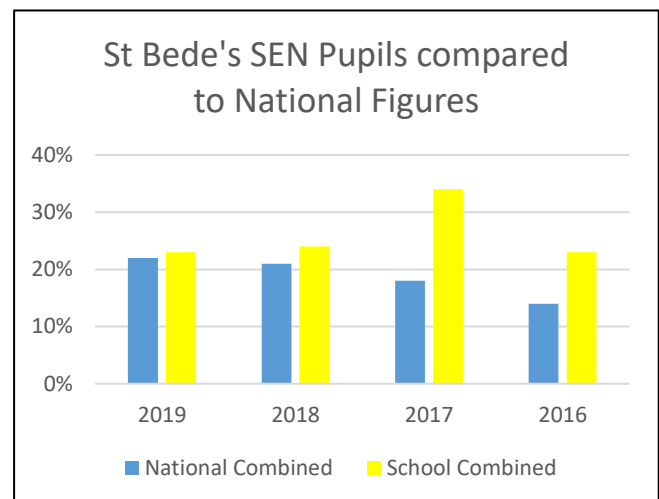
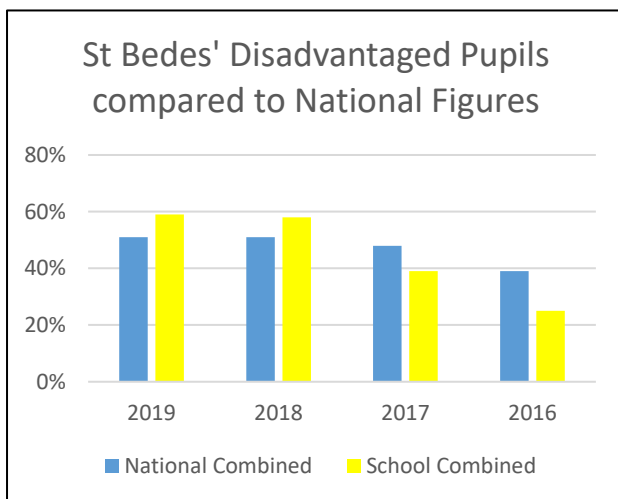
## SAT's Results and Whole School Data

### KS2 SAT's Results

We know from published performance data that pupils at middle schools, on average, have lower progress scores at the end of key stage 2 than pupils at primary schools. Also, due to the age range of pupils at middle schools, pupils will have only attended a middle school for a short time before they take their key stage 2 tests and will still have a number of years left at the school. This should be taken into account when comparing their results to schools which start educating their pupils from the beginning of key stage 1.

However, you can see from the tables below that pupils at St Bede's are performing on or above National Standard in all subjects and there has been a steady increase in progress and attainment over the past three years in our KS2 SAT's results. There is also a breakdown of our achievements by our Disadvantaged Pupils, SEN (Special Education Needs) Pupils and EAL (English Additional Language) Pupils.

- Disadvantaged pupils (16% of pupils at St Bede's) attainment has steadily increased over the past three years. Our Disadvantaged pupils are now performing significantly above National Standards
- SEN pupils (15% of pupils at St Bede's) attainment is affected by the needs of each individual cohort, but here at St Bede's, SEN pupils have consistently achieved higher than the National Standard over the past four years
- EAL pupils (34% of pupils at St Bede's) attainment has steadily increased over the past three years so EAL pupils are now working significantly above National Expectation

## Whole School Data

As a school we use GL Assessments to measure the performance of our pupils against National Expectations. GL Assessment is a nationally recognised company whose assessments are widely used across the UK, and their assessments give us an accurate picture of how our pupils are comparing to national standards.
