Year 8 pupils have produced some excellent work in Music and Art so far this year which is of a good enough standard to be entered for an Arts Award from Trinity College London in the Summer Term.

There is a Bronze level award and a Silver Arts Award. The Bronze award is a Level 1 Award working at the same standard as GCSE grades D–G/3–1. The Silver award is a Level 2 Award working at the same standard as GCSE grades A*–C.

Those pupils working towards a Silver award have already made this decision and submitted work towards this. All other pupils will continue with their work for a Bronze level award.

For those pupils already signed up for the Silver Arts Award, the amount due is £30 and this will be added onto ParentPay, minus any funds that pupils may have individually raised.
