



## INTERIM UNIFORM POLICY 2020 – 2021 (COVID -19)

### School Uniform

Due to the current situation that we find ourselves in during these unprecedented times, St Bede's have reflected upon their Uniform Policy and we have made some changes to make it easier for parents/carers to purchase clothing and have enough uniform to change on a daily basis. The changes to the policy are highlighted in red.

## UNIFORM

### GIRLS UNIFORM

- Grey, knee length, box pleated skirt – NOT mini, straight cut skirts or culottes
- Black or grey straight leg, loose fitting, tailored trousers – NOT bootleg, skinny fit or leggings
- Navy blue v-neck jumper or cardigan (optional, however, with pupils not having to wear a blazer, a jumper or cardigan will be appropriate for the colder weather)
- Navy blue blazer with school badge (blazer's will not have to be worn in the interim)
- White shirt (pupils will be able to wear a plain blue polo shirt)
- Navy blue tie with school crest (ties will not have to be worn during the interim)
- Blue Polo Shirt with school logo (Summer term ONLY) (pupils can wear a plain blue polo shirt from September – no logo)
- White, navy or black ankle or knee length socks
- Black, flat shoes (Max 1½" heel). No fashion shoes. NO sandals, high heeled, open toed, boots, Ballet style or canvas shoes (see photos)
- Headscarf/Headband – plain navy blue only

### GIRLS PE KIT

- White polo shirt – with school logo
- Royal blue shorts with school logo or Navy blue skort with logo

- Navy half zip sweat shirt – with school logo
- Royal blue knee length socks with logo
- White ankle socks
- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms with logo or sports leggings with logo (both optional)
- Training shoes or pumps (NOT black soled)
- Shin pads
- Mouth guard

### DRESS STANDARDS FOR GIRLS

Please find samples of skirts which are acceptable school uniform. Please note that the skirt needs to be of an appropriate length (see illustration). Trousers should be grey or black and of acceptable width (NOT bootleg, no jeans, leggings or chinos).

These images are guides to the high expectations that St Bede's Catholic Middle School has regarding our uniform.



## BOYS UNIFORM

- Grey or black trousers
- Grey or black tailored shorts (Summer term ONLY)
- Navy blue v-neck jumper (optional, however, with pupils not having to wear a blazer, a navy-blue jumper will be appropriate for the colder weather)
- Navy blue blazer with school badge (blazer's will not have to be worn in the interim)
- White shirt (pupils will be able to wear a plain blue polo shirt)
- Navy blue tie with school crest (ties will not have to be worn during the interim)
- Blue Polo Shirt with school logo (pupils can wear a blue polo shirt from September – no logo)
- Grey or black socks (not white or coloured)
- Plain black leather look shoes (not brown/tan shoes, boots) (see attached photos)

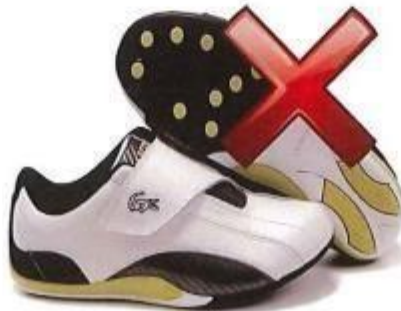
## BOYS PE KIT

- Royal blue reversible Rugby shirt
- Royal blue shorts with school logo
- Royal blue knee length socks with logo
- White polo shirt – with school logo
- White socks
- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms with logo (Optional)
- Training shoes or pumps (NOT black soled)
- Football boots
- Shin pads
- Mouth guard

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- Pupils can wear one pair of **discreet**, stud earrings in the **lobe** of the ear (earrings are to be removed for PE and Games)
- No nose piercings to be worn
- Hair must be kept tidy and out of pupils' eyes
- Boys or Girls – if hair is long enough it must be tied back
- Hair should not be dyed
- Hair should be cut in a conventional style / hair should not be partially shaved
- No cosmetics or nail polish to be worn
