

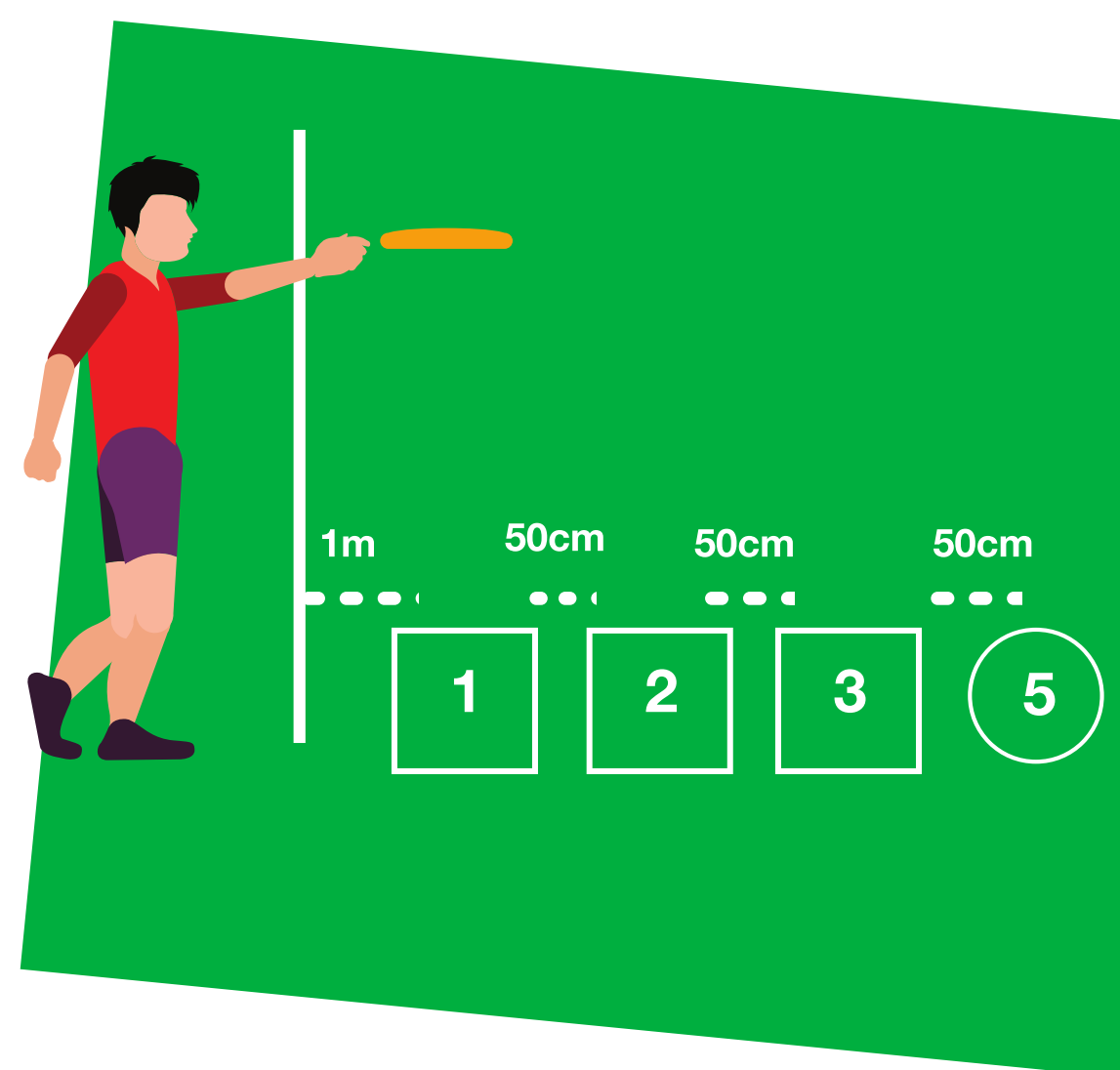
TARGET SECONDARY SCHOOL CHALLENGE 'HIT THE MARK': 8 - 12TH JUNE 2020

This competition is a test of accuracy, concentration and hand eye coordination!

- You will need a line marker (socks, pegs, tins etc.), hoops as your target (made from tea towels or towels) and a bucket or bin. You will also need 4 bean bags (socks folded over) and a stop watch.
- The object is to throw the items standing behind the throw line at the numbered targets. Keep tally of your points with each successful hit. How many points can you score in **60 seconds**? At the end of the time record your total score.

Secondary Challenge:

- Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 – Set your throw line and targets up as shown in the diagram
- Have 4 objects ready to throw (& be ready/have someone else ready to retrieve these as quickly as possible) & your timer ready. How many points can you score in **60 seconds**?
- If your object lands on target 1 score 1 point, on target 2-score 2 points, on target 3-score 3 points. If your object lands in the bin/bucket, score 5 points
- Keep count as you go & at the end of the 60 seconds record your total score.
